



ENERGY POLICY

1.1 Statement of Purpose

NLNG Shipping Management Limited ("NSML") as a major player in the global energy sector, considers managing energy and curbing environmental impact associated with its operations an important part of the way it does business. To this end, NSML seeks to continually improve the Green House Gas emissions and overall energy performance of its assets.

1.2 Policy Objectives

NSML's objectives under this policy are:

1.3 Scope and Application

- Procurement of new energy critical equipment;
- Design of new facilities;
- Expansion of existing facilities; and
- Training of its personnel.

1.4 Policy Statement

NSML is committed to operating its business in an energy efficient manner by minimising waste and continuously improving its energy performance in all activities.

1.5 Implementation

To achieve these objectives, NSML will:

- Comply with all relevant legislation and regulations;
- Make available necessary information and resources to achieve any agreed objectives and targets;
- Set and measure targets for improvement, and establish a framework to appraise and report on performance;
- Adopt operating practices that seek to minimise adverse impact through management practices, continual improvement and learning;
