It is NSML's policy to manage maritime security risks as a business through a systematic process of Identification, assessment, management, recovery and review whereby

- The company strives through its industrial, public and community relations' policies and strategies to minimise the incidences of security risks.
- The company works within the law to adopt proactive measures to protect its staff and managed vessels against identified security threats.
- Where enforcement on or within company property is required, strict adherence of the "Use of force" guidelines will be applied, bearing in mind the constitutional rights of the individual.
- In case of emergency, NSML response to security threats will be directed towards the protection of human life, environment and managed vessels. In such cases, NSML will immediately inform the appropriate security and government agencies.
- In circumstances where lives or fleet vessels are at risk, the company will inform the appropriate authorities.
- The company will ensure that where its contractors manage their own security, they do so in compliance with NSML security policies and practices.
